Oklahoma statutes as currently written do not prohibit someone from placing title to parcels of real property into separate LLC's. <u>Each</u> LLC, if it owned a benefit unit for land it owned within the District, would be able to vote because the benefit units are held in separate LLC's. The net effect of this is that a person who owned voting control of 10 LLC's and each LLC owned a parcel of real property and each LLC owned a benefit unit that corresponds to the parcel, allows "the control person" to vote on behalf of each LLC separately equating to 10 votes under this illustration.
